From Family Planning to HIV Prevention



Objectives

- ⦿ Normalisation of condoms
- ⦿ Increase access to socially marketed condoms, optimisation of free supply condoms
- ⦿ Increase the condom use from 1.6 bn in 2005 to 3.5 bn by 2012
- ⦿ Increase the number of condom outlets from 1 mn in 2006 to 3 mn by 2012; thrust on non-traditional outlets

Innovations

- ⦿ 19,700 Condom Vending Machines installed
- ⦿ Female condoms available to FSW in targeted intervention sites of four states; scaling up in other states
